House Bill 1205 (Carroll County Delegation)

Judicial Proceedings

Carroll County - Special Deputy Sheriffs

This bill authorizes the Sheriff of Carroll County to appoint special deputy sheriffs who are members of a municipal police force in the county, selected by the municipal police chief, and verified as having achieved the minimal level of training for police duties in a municipality as designated by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Deputizing municipal police officers would not directly affect Carroll County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Sheriff of Carroll County is not permitted to appoint special deputy sheriffs.

Background: Carroll County advises that special deputy sheriffs deputized by the Carroll County Sheriff would be able to legally take police action in response to an emergency outside their normal jurisdictions.
