Appropriations

Prince George's County - Laurel Regional Hospital Loan of 1999

This bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2001 to June 1, 2003, for the Board of Directors of Laurel Regional Hospital, as grantee, to provide matching funds of up to \$895,000 for the Prince George's County – Laurel Regional Hospital Loan of 1999.

The bill is effective June 1, 2001.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Extending the deadline for the provision of matching funds will not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 249 of 1999 authorized up to \$895,000 in matching funds to the grantee for the acquisition, planning, design, renovation, repair, and capital equipping of a consolidated mental health services unit, to be located at 7200 Van Dusen Road in Laurel.

Background: The grantee has raised funds exceeding \$400,000 toward the required match to date and expects to complete construction of the project by August 2001. The

grantee has made design modifications to the project in order to serve a more diverse population.
