**Talbot County - Chief Deputy Sheriff and Deputy Sheriffs - Employment Status**

This bill establishes that the Chief Deputy Sheriff of Talbot County serves at the pleasure of the county Sheriff and provides that the Sheriff cannot refuse to reappoint a deputy sheriff without just cause.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Providing that the Chief Deputy Sheriff of Talbot County serves at the pleasure of the county Sheriff would not directly affect Talbot County finances.

**Current Law:** There are no laws permitting the appointment of a chief deputy sheriff or whether the Sheriff can refuse to reappoint a deputy sheriff.
