**Social Security Trust Fund - Use for Child Support Payments**

This bill urges the U. S. Congress to allow the Social Security Trust Fund to be accessed by certain low-income noncustodial parents to assist them in meeting their financial obligations to their children, and to provide that moneys taken from the Social Security Trust Fund may either be repaid by the noncustodial parent or deducted from the noncustodial parent's future benefits.
