FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 347 (Charles County Delegation)

Commerce and Government Matters

Budget and Taxation

Charles County - Salary - County Treasurer

This bill increases the annual salary of the Treasurer of Charles County from \$40,000 to \$42,000, on January 1, 2003 and by an additional \$1,000 in each of the next three years until the salary reaches \$45,000 on January 1, 2006.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Charles County expenditures would increase by \$1,200 in FY 2003 and by \$5,800 in FY 2007. County revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Treasurer of Charles County is paid an annual salary of \$40,000. Salary adjustments for constitutional officers take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which begins in January 2003 for the Treasurer of Charles County.

Background: The salary for the Treasurer of Charles County has not changed since 1999 when the Treasurer's salary was increased from \$37,710 to \$40,000 (Chapter 537 of 1997).

Local Fiscal Effect: Charles County expenditures will increase by \$1,165 in fiscal 2003 for additional salary and benefits (16.5%), which accounts for the beginning of the next

term of office in January 2003. Charles County expenditures will increase by \$2,913 in fiscal 2004, by \$4,078 in fiscal 2005, by \$5,243 in fiscal 2006, and by \$5,825 in fiscal 2007 and each year thereafter.
