**Prince George's County - Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights -
Interrogations
PG 304-01**

This bill prohibits, under the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights, the suspension of the interrogation of an officer of the Prince George's County Police Department in a case involving the officer and a discharge of a weapon, or a case involving the death of an individual while in the custody of the officer.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill's changes are not expected to materially affect Prince George's County operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Generally, an interrogation of a law enforcement officer must be suspended for up to ten days while the officer seeks legal representation.
