- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 SECTION SUBJECTS THE INDIVIDUAL MAKING IT TO THE PENALTIES FOR PERJURY 4 TO THE SAME EXTENT AS AN OATH OR AFFIRMATION MADE BEFORE AN INDIVIDUAL
- 5 AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6
- 7 October 1, 2002.
