HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Coal Miners - Commemorative Stamp**

3 FOR the purpose of urging the United States Postal Service to issue a coal miner's  
4 postal stamp.

5 WHEREAS, Our entire nation owes coal miners a great deal more than could  
6 ever be repaid for the difficult and dangerous job they have performed so that we  
7 could have the fuel needed to operate the nation's industries and provide energy to  
8 consumers; and

9 WHEREAS, It would be fitting for the nation to recognize and pay tribute to the  
10 coal miners, both past and present, who have toiled so hard and who have made such  
11 major contributions to the energy needs of our country and its citizens; now, therefore,  
12 be it

13 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the  
14 General Assembly urges the United States Postal Service to honor and pay tribute to  
15 the past and present coal miners of this nation by issuing a commemorative postal  
16 stamp in their honor; and be it further
