A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Automotive Warranty Enforcement Act - Motor Homes**

3 FOR the purpose of making the provisions of the Automotive Warranty Enforcement
4 Act applicable to motor homes; altering a certain definition; repealing a
5 requirement that the Motor Vehicle Administration promulgate a certain
6 regulation; and generally relating to motor homes and the Automotive Warranty
7 Enforcement Act.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Commercial Law**

16 14-1501.

17 (c) [(1)] "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is registered in this State as a:

18 [(i)] (1) Class A (passenger) vehicle;

19 [(ii)] (2) Class D (motorcycle) vehicle;

20 [(iii)] (3) Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less
21 manufacturer's rated capacity; or

22 [(iv)] (4) Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

23 [(2)] "Motor vehicle" does not include a motor home. For the purpose of
24 administering this subtitle, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall promulgate a
25 regulation defining a motor home.]

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2002.
