CHAPTER 237

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Location of Licensed Premises**
3 **MC 211-02**

4 FOR the purpose of substituting a certain zoning classification used in the City of
5 Rockville for one used elsewhere in Montgomery County to describe the area in
6 which a restaurant with a certain Class B (hotel-restaurant or hotel-motel)
7 beer, wine and liquor on-sale only license may be located; and generally relating
8 to alcoholic beverages licenses in Montgomery County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

2 9-102.1.

3 (a) This section applies only in Montgomery County.

4 (b) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

5 (4) "License" means a Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale only license.

6 (c) After making an application and paying the fees, the holder of an original
7 license may obtain the additional license or licenses authorized by this section.8 (g) (1) A licensee may obtain one additional license for premises which meet
9 the qualifications specified in this subsection. For identification purposes, this
10 additional license may be referred to as a "Rockville" license.11 (2) The restaurant shall be located within [CBD zoned property within
12 the Rockville Town Center mixed use district] **THE ROCKVILLE TOWN CENTER ZONED**
13 **PROPERTY.**14 (3) The requirement that the holder have been a licensee for 1 year does
15 not apply to this subsection.16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
17 effect July 1, 2002.
