15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

18 23-401.

19 (a) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:

20 (1) the member completes and submits a written application to the  
21 Board of Trustees stating the date when the member desires to retire; and

1 (2) on or before the date of retirement, the member:

2 (i) has at least 30 years of eligibility service; [or]

3 (ii) HAS A COMBINED TOTAL OF AT LEAST 30 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY  
4 SERVICE FROM THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM, THE TEACHERS' PENSION  
5 SYSTEM, THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OR THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT  
6 SYSTEM; OR

7 (III) has attained the age and the years of eligibility service as  
8 follows:

9 Age	Years of Eligibility Service
10 62 with 5	
11 63 with 4	
12 64 with 3	
13 65 or more with 2	

14 (b) Except as provided in [subsection (c)] SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) of this  
15 section, on retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal  
16 service retirement allowance that equals the number of years of the member's  
17 creditable service multiplied by:

18 (1) 0.8% of the member's average final compensation that is not in excess  
19 of the Social Security integration level; and

20 (2) 1.5% of the member's average final compensation that exceeds the  
21 Social Security integration level.

22 (c) [On] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, ON  
23 retirement under this section, a member who is subject to the contributory pension  
24 benefit under Subtitle 2, Part II of this title is entitled to receive a normal service  
25 retirement allowance that equals the sum of:

26 (1) the number of years of the member's creditable service on or after  
27 July 1, 1998 multiplied by 1.4% of the member's average final compensation; and

28 (2) the greater of:

29 (i) the number of years of the member's creditable service on or  
30 before June 30, 1998 multiplied by 1.2% of the member's average final compensation;
