CHAPTER 91

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County - Sheriff - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Cecil County; providing that
4 this Act does not apply to the salary of the incumbent Sheriff; and generally
5 relating to the salary of the Sheriff of Cecil County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2-309.

15 (i) (1) (i) The Sheriff of Cecil County shall receive an annual salary [of]
16 OF:

- 17 1. \$47,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;
- 18 2. \$50,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;
- 19 3. \$51,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004;

1 [(vi)] (VII) Except for the chief deputy sheriff, community adult
2 rehabilitation center administrator, detention center director, detention center deputy
3 director, law enforcement director, law enforcement personnel, and personal secretary
4 to the Sheriff, all employees of the Sheriff's department:

5 1. Shall be governed by the rank, salary, and benefit
6 structures of the Cecil County personnel policy; and

7 2. Upon completion of the probationary period, shall be
8 subject to the Cecil County personnel regulations and policies in all matters.

9 [(vii)] (VIII) Nothing in this subsection shall affect the rights and
10 protections accorded an employee under any other provision of law.

11 (2) The County Commissioners shall pay the cost of all necessary
12 expenses incurred by the Sheriff and his staff.

13 (3) The Sheriff of Cecil County shall have the authority to formulate and
14 administer a plan that includes the method of supervision to use inmates the Sheriff
15 deems eligible and selects to perform, under the supervision of State, county, or
16 municipal employees, tasks the Sheriff assigns within the county or any incorporated
17 municipality within the county.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
19 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
20 apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Cecil County in office on the
21 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
22 compensation of the Sheriff of Cecil County shall take effect at the beginning of the
23 next following term of office.

24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 2002.
