AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 690

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, strike beginning with “requiring” through “make” and substitute “altering the”; strike beginning with “specifying” in line 6 down through “benefits;” in line 7 and substitute “providing that the combined payments to a surviving spouse who was wholly dependent at the time of the covered employee’s death but who later becomes partly self-supporting may not exceed a certain amount under certain circumstances; repealing a requirement that an employer or insurer continue to make certain payments in the case of a remarriage of a wholly or partly dependent spouse;”; in line 8, after “wholly” insert “or partly”; strike beginning with “who” in line 8 down through “compensation” in line 10; in line 13, after “9-681” insert “and 9-682”; and strike in their entirety lines 16 through 20, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with the colon in line 25 down through “TIME” in line 30 and substitute “AT THE SAME WEEKLY RATE”; in line 33, strike beginning with “(1)” through “if” and substitute “IF”; and strike in their entirety lines 36 and 37.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 14, after “paid” insert “, INCLUDING ANY PAYMENTS MADE DURING A PERIOD OF TOTAL DEPENDENCY UNDER § 9-681 OF THIS SUBTITLE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 15, strike beginning with “(1)” through “if” and substitute “IF”; strike beginning with “and” in line 16 down through “\$60,000” in line 20 and substitute “, PAYMENT TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE SHALL STOP ON THE DATE OF THE REMARRIAGE, EVEN IF \$60,000 HAS NOT BEEN PAID”.
