A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Board of Education - Elected Members**  
3 **PG 412-03**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain date on which the members of the New Prince  
5 George's County Board of Education are entitled to receive certain  
6 compensation; altering a certain date terminating the terms of the appointed  
7 members of the New County Board; altering the effective date of certain  
8 provisions of a certain Act; and generally relating to the members of the New  
9 Prince George's County Board of Education.

18 Section 10, 20, and 21

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article - Education**

22 3-1003.

23 (a) From and after [December 4, 2006] DECEMBER 6, 2004, at the beginning of  
24 each member's full term, the chairman of the county Board is entitled to receive  
25 \$19,000 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to  
26 receive \$18,000 annually as compensation.

**Chapter 289 of the Acts of 2002**

2 SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of office of the  
3 members of the New Prince George's County Board of Education appointed under  
4 Section 3 of this Act begin on June 1, 2002. The terms of those members, or their  
5 successors selected to fill a vacancy, who are in office on June 1, [2006] 2004 shall  
6 terminate on [December 3, 2006] DECEMBER 5, 2004.

7 SECTION 20. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 through 3 of  
8 this Act shall take effect June 1, 2002. They shall remain effective for a period of [4]  
9 2 years and 1 month, and, at the end of June 30, [2006] 2004, with no further action  
10 required by the General Assembly, Sections 1 through 3 of this Act shall be abrogated  
11 and of no further force and effect.

12 SECTION 21. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 6 and 7 of this  
13 Act shall take effect July 1, [2006] 2004.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
15 October 1, 2003.
