CHAPTER 184

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Servers in Restaurants**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing in Carroll County a certain condition under which a
4 person who is 18 years old or older may serve and sell alcoholic beverages in
5 restaurants; allowing in Carroll County a person who is 18 years old or older to
6 deliver alcoholic beverages in restaurants; and generally relating to alcoholic
7 beverages in Carroll County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

3 (b) (4) (i) The provisions of this paragraph apply only in Carroll County.

4 (iii) A person 18 years old [and] OR older may serve, [and] sell, OR
5 DELIVER alcoholic beverages in restaurants [in connection with the serving and
6 selling of a meal].

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2003.
