11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Insurance**

14 15-909.

15 (b) (3) (i) If an application for a Medicare supplement policy or certificate
16 is submitted by an individual who is under the age of 65 years, but is eligible for
17 Medicare due to a disability, DURING THE 6-MONTH PERIOD FOLLOWING THE
18 APPLICANT'S ENROLLMENT IN PART B OF MEDICARE, a ~~{carrier,}~~ CARRIER shall
19 make available to the applicant both a Medicare supplement policy plan C and a
20 Medicare supplement policy plan I.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 July 1, 2003.
