AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 384

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “and” in line 7 down through “met” in line 8 and substitute “under certain conditions”; and in line 13, after “City” insert “under certain conditions”.

On page 2, in line 5, strike “and (x)” and substitute “, (x), and (xi)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 18, insert:

“(X) UNTIL JULY 1, 2005, THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR BALTIMORE CITY MAY ISSUE A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN A RESTAURANT THAT HAS A SEATING CAPACITY EXCEEDING 150 PERSONS IF THE RESTAURANT:

1. IS AN ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED IN AN AREA IDENTIFIED IN § 9-204(E)(1) OF THIS ARTICLE;

2. HAS A MINIMUM CAPITAL INVESTMENT OF \$1,000,000; AND

3. HAS AVERAGE DAILY RECEIPTS FROM THE SALE OF FOOD THAT ARE AT LEAST 70% OF THE TOTAL DAILY RECEIPTS.”;

and in line 19, strike “(X)” and substitute “(XI)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 27, strike “47TH” and substitute “46TH”; and strike in their entirety lines

(Over)

29 through 35, inclusive, and substitute:

“(II) THE BOARD MAY NOT TRANSFER OR ISSUE A LICENSE IN THE 46TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT, WHICH AT ALL TIMES SHALL BE COTERMINOUS WITH THE 46TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTING PLAN OF 2002 AS ORDERED BY THE MARYLAND COURT OF APPEALS ON JUNE 21, 2002, IF THE TRANSFER OR ISSUANCE WOULD RESULT IN:

1. THE LICENSED PREMISES BEING LOCATED WITHIN 300 FEET OF THE NEAREST POINT OF A CHURCH OR A SCHOOL; OR

2. THE LICENSED PREMISES BEING LOCATED CLOSER TO THE NEAREST POINT OF A CHURCH OR A SCHOOL THAN THE LICENSED PREMISES WAS ON JUNE 1, 2004.”.

On page 6, in line 7, strike “precinct” and substitute “PRECINCTS 3 AND”.
