3 FOR the purpose of altering the requirement that each county provide an office for
4 the supervisor of assessments of the county to allow the office to be located
5 anywhere in the county.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Tax - Property**

14 2-106.

15 [Each county] THE DEPARTMENT shall provide the supervisor of the county
16 with an office in the county [seat] or in Baltimore City, for the supervisor of
17 Baltimore City. The Department is responsible for providing each supervisor with
18 clerical staff, equipment, and other facilities and assistance that the Department
19 considers necessary and as provided in the State budget.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 July 1, 2004.
