1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy - Sentencing Guidelines**  
3 **Worksheet - Information Relating to Economic Crimes**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy to  
5 include certain entry information on a certain worksheet for a court to report  
6 certain information relating to certain theft and fraud crimes; and generally  
7 relating to the State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy.

8 BY adding to  
9 Article - Criminal Procedure  
10 Section 6-214  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2001 Volume and 2003 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

16 6-214.

14     SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
15 effect October 1, 2004.
