CHAPTER 302

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Employees - Unused Annual Leave - Special Pay Plan**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Special Pay Plan for the purpose of allowing
4 certain State employees to contribute to a certain plan with tax-qualified status
5 under the Internal Revenue Code; requiring ~~the Comptroller, in consultation~~
6 ~~with the Secretary of Budget and Management, to administer the Special Pay~~
7 ~~Plan, Management or the Secretary's designee to adopt certain regulations, and~~
8 ~~regulations; requiring authorizing the Secretary or the Secretary's designee to~~
9 adopt, implement, and maintain the Special Pay Plan qualified under the
10 Internal Revenue Code; requiring the ~~Comptroller~~ Secretary or the Secretary's
11 designee to hire certain entities; providing for the vesting of a participating
12 employee in the Special Pay Plan; providing for the distribution of a
13 participating employee's interest in the Special Pay Plan; providing for the
14 duties of certain entities hired by the ~~Comptroller~~ Secretary or the Secretary's
15 designee; providing for the indemnification of certain entities; requiring the
16 ~~Secretary of Budget and Management~~ Secretary or the Secretary's designee to adopt
17 regulations to establish certain eligibility criteria for participants in the Special

1 Pay Plan; requiring that participation in the Special Pay Plan is mandatory;
 2 requiring the ~~Comptroller~~ Secretary or the Secretary's designee to make certain
 3 contributions to the Special Pay Plan on behalf of certain employees; requiring
 4 the ~~Comptroller and Secretary of Budget and Management~~ or the Secretary's
 5 designee to adopt regulations regarding the certain contributions to the Special
 6 Pay Plan; defining certain terms; *providing for the delayed effective date of this*
 7 *Act*; and generally relating to establishing a Special Pay Plan for State
 8 employees.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

28 (D) "PARTICIPATING EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEE WHO
 29 PARTICIPATES IN THE SPECIAL PAY PLAN.

30 (E) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT.

31 (F) "SPECIAL PAY PLAN" MEANS A QUALIFIED TRUST ESTABLISHED UNDER §
 32 401(A) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

34 (A) THE SPECIAL PAY PLAN IS IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER RETIREMENT,
 35 PENSION, OR BENEFIT SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE.

1 (B) ~~A DEFERRAL OF COMPENSATION ANY CONTRIBUTION~~ UNDER THE
 2 SPECIAL PAY PLAN DOES NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF ANY RETIREMENT, PENSION,
 3 OR OTHER BENEFIT PROVIDED BY STATE LAW.

16 SECRETARY OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE ANY INFORMATION REQUESTED
17 REGARDING THE DESIGNATED COMPANY, THE SPECIAL PAY PLAN, OR THE
18 INVESTMENT OPTIONS OFFERED BY THE DESIGNATED COMPANY.

19 (B) THE DESIGNATED COMPANY SHALL PROVIDE AND PAY FOR ALL
