CHAPTER 482

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment - Controlled Hazardous Substance Facility - Permit Term**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the maximum term of certain controlled hazardous
4 substance facility permits; and generally relating to controlled hazardous
5 substance facility permits.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Environment**

14 7-238.

15 (a) (1) Unless it is renewed for another term, a facility permit expires on the
16 expiration date the Department specifies at issuance or renewal.

17 (2) Unless the controlled hazardous substance facility is a low-level
18 nuclear waste facility, the Department may not issue a facility permit for a term
19 longer than [5] 10 years. The Department may issue a low-level nuclear waste
20 facility permit for a term not longer than 5 years.

- 1 (b) The Department may renew a facility permit if the permit holder:
- 2 (1) Has complied with all appropriate rules and regulations;
- 3 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the Department; and
- 4 (3) Submits to the Department a renewal application on the form the
- 5 Department requires.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

7 October 1, 2004.
