CHAPTER 553

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Liability Insurance - Minors - Settlement of Claims**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that a parent of a minor or person in loco parentis of the
4 minor may settle a claim under a liability insurance policy brought by the
5 parent or person in loco parentis for the benefit of the minor; requiring payment
6 of the settlement to comply with certain provisions of law; providing for the
7 application of this Act; and generally relating to settlement of claims under
8 liability insurance policies for the benefit of a minor.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Insurance**

17 19-113.

18 (A) A PARENT OF A MINOR OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS OF THE MINOR MAY
19 SETTLE A CLAIM UNDER A LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY BROUGHT BY THE PARENT
20 OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MINOR.

1 (B) THE PAYMENT OF A SETTLEMENT OF A CLAIM MADE UNDER THIS
2 SECTION FOR THE BENEFIT OF A MINOR SHALL COMPLY WITH TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 4
3 OF THE ESTATES AND TRUSTS ARTICLE.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to
5 claims under policies of liability insurance arising on or after the effective date of this
6 Act.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 June 1, 2004.
