FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 875 (Frederick County Delegation)
Environmental Matters

**Frederick County - Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway - Memorial Sign
or Marker**

This bill directs the State Highway Administration (SHA) to consult with the Frederick County chapter of the Korean War Veterans (No. 142) on the design of one or more memorial signs or other markers to indicate that the portion of Interstate 70 in Frederick County has been designated as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway. SHA may accept donations from the chapter to pay for the design and placement of memorial signs or markers and must erect a sign or marker upon receipt of donations sufficient to cover related costs.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The cost of erecting a memorial, estimated to be \$5,000 to \$10,000, would not affect the Transportation Trust Fund because the costs would be provided by a private source.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 512 of 2002 required SHA to designate the portion of Interstate 70 that is in Frederick County as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.
