AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 373

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 19, strike “2006” and substitute “2005”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 2, strike “and”; in line 3, after “oxygenates” insert “:

(4) The effectiveness and efficiency of the use of bacteria and other microorganisms to clean both isolated and widespread incidences of oil and gasoline contamination of soil and groundwater, a process known as “bioremediation”; and

(5) The short and long term effectiveness of bioremediation compared to other methods of cleaning soil and groundwater contamination”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 5, strike “October” and substitute “July”; in the same line, strike “1 year and 3” and substitute “6”; and in line 6, strike “2006” and substitute “2005”.
