1 **Article - Transportation** 2 21-901.1. A person is guilty of reckless driving if [he] THE PERSON drives a motor 3 (a) 4 vehicle: 5 (1) In wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property; or 6 (2)In a manner that indicates a wanton or willful disregard for the 7 safety of persons or property.
