2 **Worcester County - Liquor Control Board - Borrowing Limit**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing to a certain limit the amount of money that the Liquor  
4 Control Board of Worcester County may borrow; and generally relating to the  
5 Liquor Control Board of Worcester County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 15-202(b)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 15-202.

15 (b) (1) The liquor control board may borrow money from time to time from  
16 any banking institution on its own credit.

17 (2) The aggregate sum advanced to or borrowed by the liquor control  
18 board may not exceed the following amounts:

19 (i) Harford County -- \$75,000

20 (ii) Somerset County -- \$50,000
