- 19 (a) There is a program of tuition assistance under this section.
- 20 (b) Any career or volunteer firefighter, ambulance or rescue squad member
- 21 [who is a resident of Maryland] shall receive full and complete reimbursement by the
- 22 Office for tuition costs not to exceed the resident tuition rates at the 4-year public
- 23 institution of higher education within the University System of Maryland, other than
- 24 the University of Maryland University College and University of Maryland,
- 25 Baltimore, with the highest annual expenses for a full-time resident undergraduate,
- 26 for courses credited toward a degree in fire service technology or emergency medical

- 1 (c) (1) The tuition reimbursement application shall be filed with the Office 2 no later than July 1 immediately following the academic year for which tuition 3 reimbursement is sought.
- 4 (2) Payment shall be made 1 year after successful completion of each 5 academic year.
- 6 (3) Payment may be made only if the applicant is still employed or
- 7 actively engaged FOR A MINIMUM OF 20 HOURS PER WEEK ON AVERAGE as a career or
- 8 volunteer firefighter or ambulance or rescue squad member in an organized fire
- 9 department or ambulance or rescue squad in this State.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 July 1, 2005.
