1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Insurance - Property and Casualty - Filing Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain form filings require payment of certain
4 fees; requiring the Maryland Insurance Administration to collect certain fees for
5 certain filings from motor clubs and for certain other filings; and generally
6 relating to the collection of fees for certain required filings with the Maryland
7 Insurance Administration.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Insurance**

17 (a) Fees for the following certificates, licenses, and services shall be collected
18 in advance by the Commissioner, and shall be paid by the appropriate persons to the
19 Commissioner:

20 (9) fees for REQUIRED FILINGS, INCLUDING form and rate [filings]
21 FILINGS, under Title 11, Subtitles 2 [and] THROUGH 4, TITLE 26, and §§ 12-203,
22 13-110, [and] 14-126, AND 27-605 of this article \$125

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
24 effect October 1, 2005.
