- 15 (c) (1) In any action for damages filed under this subtitle, the health care
- 16 provider is not liable for the payment of damages unless it is established that the care
- 17 given by the health care provider is not in accordance with the standards of practice
- 18 among members of the same health care profession with similar training and
- 19 experience situated in the same or similar communities at the time of the alleged act
- 20 giving rise to the cause of action.
