- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Frederick County; providing

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 16 (1) The Sheriff of Frederick County shall receive a salary of [\$80,000]
- 17 \$100,000. The Sheriff shall appoint deputies as necessary, at salaries of at least \$2,400,
- 18 and jail wardens as necessary, at salaries of at least \$1,320 each. The Sheriff also may
- 19 appoint additional temporary deputy sheriffs as the Sheriff considers necessary for
- 20 the public safety, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners. The
- 21 County Commissioners shall allow reasonable compensation for the temporary
- 22 additional deputy sheriffs and the temporary deputies may not serve longer than the
- 23 occasion requires. The Sheriff may appoint a chief deputy who shall serve at the
- 24 pleasure of the Sheriff.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
- 26 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
- 27 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Frederick County in office on the effective
- 28 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation

- of the Sheriff of Frederick County shall take effect at the beginning of the next
 following term of office.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3
- 4 October 1, 2005.
