3 (b) The Secretary shall adopt regulations for the enrollment and participation 4 of employees of a qualifying not-for-profit organization to participate in the Program 5 as a satellite organization.

6 (c) A qualifying not-for-profit organization that participates in the Program 7 as a satellite organization shall:

8 (1) pay to the State:

9 (i) a premium in the amount determined by the Secretary; and

10 (ii) any costs, as determined by the Secretary, for the 11 administration of this Program; and

12 (2) determine the extent to which the organization will subsidize 13 participation by its employees in the Program.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 July 1, 2005.
