## CHAPTER\_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Special Beer Festival License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners of Carroll  
 4 County to issue a special beer festival license; specifying the scope of the license;  
 5 establishing a certain fee; specifying certain requirements imposed on  
 6 applicants for the license; requiring the Board to approve the time and location  
 7 for the special beer festival under certain conditions; requiring the Board to  
 8 ensure the primary focus of the festival; requiring the Board to adopt certain  
 9 regulations for a certain purpose; providing that this Act does not prohibit a  
 10 licensee from holding another alcoholic beverages license of a different class or  
 11 nature; defining a certain term; and generally relating to special beer festival  
 12 licenses in Carroll County.

13 BY adding to  
 14 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
 15 Section 8-805  
 16 Annotated Code of Maryland  
 17 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 8-805.

22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE  
 23 COMMISSIONERS FOR CARROLL COUNTY.

1 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE.

2 (C) A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO DISPLAY  
3 AND SELL AT RETAIL BEER FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES  
4 ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL  
5 IN CARROLL COUNTY.

6 (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, AN  
7 APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE SHALL BE THE HOLDER OF A  
8 CURRENT RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE ISSUED IN THE STATE, A CLASS 5  
9 BREWERY LICENSE, OR A CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE.

10 (E) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$200 FOR A ONE-DAY OR TWO-DAY FESTIVAL.

11 (F) THE BOARD SHALL:

12 (1) APPROVE ONE WEEKEND FOR THE SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL THAT  
13 DOES NOT FALL ON THE DATES CHOSEN FOR THE CUMBERLAND AND SHENANDOAH  
14 VALLEY WINE FESTIVAL IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, OR THE MARYLAND WINE  
15 FESTIVAL IN CARROLL COUNTY, OR THE ANNE ARUNDEL BEER AND WINE FESTIVAL;

16 (2) APPROVE A NONLICENSED PREMISES IN CARROLL COUNTY FOR THE  
17 SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL; AND

18 (3) ENSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE SPECIAL BEER  
19 FESTIVAL IS THE PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER.

20 (G) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE LICENSEE FROM HOLDING  
21 ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS OR NATURE.

22 (H) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 October 1, 2005.
