19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

3 (r) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

4 (7) (i) Members of the Board of Alcoholic Beverages License
5 Commissioners AND THE ATTORNEY FOR THE BOARD are eligible for:

- 6 1. All county health benefits; and

- 7 2. Membership in and retirement benefits of the State
-
- 8 Employees' Pension System.

9 (ii) The health benefits under this paragraph include:

- 10 1. Hospitalization;

- 11 2. Vision care;

- 12 3. Prescriptions;

- 13 4. Dental care;

- 14 5. Life insurance; and

- 15 6. Expense reimbursement.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
