A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law - Identification of Voters**

3 FOR the purpose of altering requirements of the Election Code for the identification
4 of voters by election judges at the polling place; and generally relating to polling
5 place procedures.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Election Law**

14 10-310.

15 (a) For each individual who seeks to vote, an election judge, in accordance
16 with instructions provided by the local board, shall:

17 (1) locate the individual's name in the precinct register and locate the
18 preprinted voting authority card and then authorize the individual to vote a regular
19 ballot;

20 (2) (i) if the individual's name is not found on the precinct register,
21 search the inactive list and if the name is found, authorize the individual to vote a
22 regular ballot; or

23 (ii) if the individual's name is not on the inactive list, refer the
24 individual for provisional ballot voting under § 9-404 of this article;

25 (3) establish the identity of the voter by [requesting the voter to state
26 the month and day of the voter's birth and comparing the response to the information
27 listed in the precinct register];

1 (I) REQUIRING THE VOTER TO PRESENT TO THE ELECTION JUDGE:

2 1. A DRIVER'S LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY
3 THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION, OR VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARD; OR

4 2. IF THE VOTER CANNOT PROVIDE A FORM OF
5 IDENTIFICATION SPECIFIED IN ITEM 1 OF THIS ITEM, ANY OTHER FORM OF
6 IDENTIFICATION THAT IS ISSUED BY A GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY AND THAT
7 CONTAINS THE VOTER'S NAME, ADDRESS, AND DATE OF BIRTH; OR

8 (II) IF THE VOTER DOES NOT HAVE ANY FORM OF IDENTIFICATION
9 DESCRIBED IN ITEM (I) OF THIS ITEM, REQUIRING THE VOTER TO STATE THE MONTH
10 AND DAY OF THE VOTER'S BIRTH;

11 (4) verify THE VOTER'S DATE OF BIRTH AND the address of the voter's
12 residence;

13 (5) if any changes to the voting authority card are indicated by a voter,
14 make the appropriate changes in information on the card or other appropriate form;
15 and

16 (6) have the voter sign the voting authority card and either issue the
17 voter a ballot or send the voter to a machine to vote.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2005.
