CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Hurricane Isabel Disaster Relief Act - Reporting Requirements - Financial**
3 **Assistance Applications - Extension of Termination**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Housing and Community
5 Development to issue to the General Assembly on or before a certain date an
6 interim report on the implementation of the Hurricane Isabel Disaster Relief
7 Act; altering the date on or before which the Department of Housing and
8 Community Development shall issue to the General Assembly a final report on
9 the implementation of the Hurricane Isabel Disaster Relief Act; providing that
10 all applications for financial assistance under the Hurricane Isabel Disaster
11 Relief Act shall be received by the Department by a certain date and may be
12 considered for financial assistance through a certain date; altering the date at
13 the end of which a certain section of the Hurricane Isabel Disaster Relief Act
14 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect; making this Act an
15 emergency measure; and generally relating to the Hurricane Isabel Disaster
16 Relief Act.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
8 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 **Chapter 7 of the Acts of 2004**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
11 Housing and Community Development shall issue to the General Assembly, in
12 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, a preliminary report on or
13 before September 30, 2004, AN INTERIM REPORT ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 2005,
14 and a final report on or before September 30, [2005] 2006 on the implementation of
15 this Act. The reports shall include:

16 (a) with reference to loans provided by the Department, the amounts of the
17 loans and the borrowers' counties of residence;

18 (b) with reference to loans obtained in the private market for which the
19 Department provided credit enhancements, the amounts of the credit enhancements,
20 the borrowers' counties of residence, the names of the financial institutions that
21 provided the loans, and the amounts of the loans; and

22 (c) with reference to other financial assistance provided, including financial
23 assistance provided under the buy-down program, the amounts and sources of the
24 financial assistance and the borrowers' counties of residence.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
26 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
27 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
28 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
29 effect from the date it is enacted. Section 1 of this Act shall remain effective through
30 ~~May 31 June 30~~ May 31, [2005] 2006 and, at the end of ~~May 31 June 30~~ May 31,
31 [2005] 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 1 of
