- 34 comply with the van-accessible parking ratio requirement of the Maryland
- 35 Accessibility Code in the review and revision of its comprehensive zoning plan next
- 36 occurring after the effective date of this Act.
- 37 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 38 October 1, 2005 January 1, 2006.
