## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Highways - Prohibition on Use for Solicitation**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway, median divider,  
4 or intersection in Carroll County to solicit money or donations from the occupant  
5 of a vehicle; and generally relating to restrictions on the use of highways for  
6 solicitation in Carroll County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article - Transportation  
9 Section 21-507(c)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2002 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 21-507.

16 (c) In CARROLL COUNTY, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County,  
17 and Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or  
18 intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 2005.
