- 17 (3) the Secretary of Transportation or the Secretary's designee;
- the Secretary of Business and Economic Development or the
- 19 Secretary's designee; and
- 20 (5) the following members appointed by the Governor:
- 21 (i) six representatives of companies doing business at or with the
- 22 Port of Baltimore: and
- 23 (ii) three representatives of labor unions with members working at
- 24 the Port of Baltimore.

- 1 (d) The Department of Legislative Services shall provide staff for the 2 Committee. 3 (e) A member of the Committee: 4 (1) may not receive compensation; but (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 6 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget. The Committee shall: 7 (f) examine the feasibility of establishing a port authority, independent
- 10 (2) assess the effects of an independent port authority operating the Port
- 11 of Baltimore on the Port, the Department of Transportation, and the Transportation 12 Trust Fund;
