It authorizes the holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at the place described in it, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. A license may not be issued for any drugstore.
27	(e) (1) This subsection applies only in Baltimore County.

2 (3) The area of the licensed premises normally used for the preparation
