A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages Inspector - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary in Frederick County of the county alcoholic
4 beverages inspector; and generally relating to the salary of the alcoholic
5 beverages inspector in Frederick County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

19 15-103.

20 (d) (6) (i) An inspector shall receive an annual salary [of \$35,000,] AS
21 SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, be reimbursed for reasonable expenses, and
22 receive mileage at the standard rate set by the County Commissioners.

23 (ii) Mileage does not include travel to and from the inspector's
24 home and office.

25 (7) An inspector shall:

- 1 (i) Possess the power of a peace officer of this State with respect to
2 the enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws of Frederick County;
- 3 (ii) Make monthly reports in writing to the Board covering the
4 activities and setting forth any complaints or violations that may have been observed
5 or reported;
- 6 (iii) Assist the Board in enforcing the alcoholic beverages laws; and
- 7 (iv) Have any other duties as the Board may prescribe.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
9 effect October 1, 2005.
