## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Historic Bostwick House

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$317,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of
- 5 Bladensburg for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for
- 6 disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee
- 7 provide and expend a matching fund; requiring the grantee to grant and convey
- 8 a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust; establishing a deadline for
- 9 the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; and providing generally
- for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 15 George's County Historic Bostwick House Loan of 2005 in the total principal
- 16 amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$317,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
- 17 provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the
- 18 issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a
- 19 resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance
- 20 with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and
- 21 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 25 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 26 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 27 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 28 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 29 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 30 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town
- 31 of Bladensburg (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the design,

- 1 repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the historic Bostwick
- 2 House, including grounds stabilization, structural rehabilitation, fire protection
- 3 systems and utility improvements, air conditioning, and other improvements to make
- 4 the facility compliant with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act, located in
- 5 Bladensburg.
- 6 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 7 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and
- 8 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 9 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 10 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 11 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 12 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 13 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 14 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or funds expended
- 15 prior to the effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of in kind contributions. In
- 16 case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets
- 17 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter
- 18 and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2007, to present
- 19 evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be
- 20 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the
- 21 State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes
- 22 provided in this Act.
- 23 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 24 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 25 its interest:
- 26 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 27 and
- 28 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 29 structures.
- 30 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land
- 31 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.
- 32 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 33 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable
- 34 to the Trust.
- 35 (7) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 36 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2012. If any
- 37 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 38 2012, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 39 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 40 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 41 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 2005.
