CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Part-Time Inspectors and**  
 3 **Class B-MB/22 Licenses**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B-MB/22 license in a certain legislative  
 5 district of Prince George's County; authorizing the Class B-MB/22 license to be  
 6 issued only to certain persons; setting an annual fee; authorizing the holder of  
 7 both a Class B-MB/22 license and a certain micro-brewery license to hold a  
 8 certain additional license; specifying that a Class B-MB/22 license holder is  
 9 entitled to sell liquor under certain conditions; increasing the number of  
 10 part-time inspectors appointed by the Board of License Commissioners of  
 11 Prince George's County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages inspectors  
 12 and alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

8 6-201.

9 (r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

10 (14) (I) THERE IS A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE, WHICH MAY BE ISSUED  
11 ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE IN THE 22ND  
12 LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.

13 (II) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$990.

14 (III) A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO SELL  
15 LIQUOR BY THE DRINK FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ONLY.

16 (IV) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE  
17 HOLDER OF A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE MAY ALSO HOLD A CLASS D LICENSE.

19 (r) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

20 (2) The Board shall appoint an administrator, an attorney, and all  
21 inspectors for the Board.

22 (3) (ii) There are three full-time and [29] 32 part-time inspectors, all  
23 of whom shall be county residents. The three full-time inspector positions shall be  
24 designated as the chief inspector and the deputy chief inspectors. The three full-time  
25 inspectors who meet the standards set out by the Prince George's County merit board  
26 and who are certified by the personnel director as meeting these standards shall be  
27 entitled to the provisions of the county merit system.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
29 October 1, 2005.
