- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS
- 23 OF SELLING OR DISTRIBUTING CIGARETTES.
- 24 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
- 25 PERSON COVERED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT:
- 26 (I) SELL OR SHIP CIGARETTES, ORDERED OR PURCHASED BY MAIL
- 27 OR THROUGH A COMPUTER NETWORK, TELEPHONIC NETWORK, OR OTHER
