CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County - Treasurer - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Treasurer of Cecil County; providing
4 that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent
5 Treasurer of Cecil County; and generally relating to the salary of the Treasurer
6 of Cecil County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 25 - County Commissioners

11 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 25 - County Commissioners**

15 51.

16 (u) (1) The salary of the County Treasurer of Cecil County is [\$60,000]:

17 (I) \$60,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2006;

18 (II) \$66,250 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2007;

19 (III) \$72,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2008;

1 (IV) \$78,750 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2009; AND

2 (V) \$85,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2010 AND EACH CALENDAR YEAR
3 THEREAFTER.

4 (2) The Treasurer may not receive any other income for performing the
5 duties of [his] THE TREASURER'S office.

6 [(2)] (3) In addition, the County Treasurer shall receive the benefits and
7 reimbursements for reasonable expenses in the performance of duties as provided in
8 the Cecil County budget or by law, including, where appropriate:

9 (i) Reimbursements under the Standard State Travel Regulations;
10 and

11 (ii) Participation in the health care plan that is negotiated for
12 county employees.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
14 § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
15 the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of Cecil County in office on the effective
16 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation
17 of the Treasurer of Cecil County shall take effect at the beginning of the next
18 following term of office.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
20 effect October 1, 2005.
