A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Sheriff - Salary and Expense Allowance**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the expense allowance amount received by the Sheriff of
4 Baltimore City; altering the salary of the Sheriff of Baltimore City; providing
5 that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent
6 Sheriff of Baltimore City; and generally relating to the salary and expense
7 allowance received by the Sheriff of Baltimore City.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 2-309.

17 (d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense
18 allowance of [\$1,000] \$750 TWO TIMES per year and a salary of:

- 19 1. [\$70,000] \$79,300 in calendar year [2002] 2007;
- 20 2. [\$70,000] \$84,600 in calendar year [2003] 2008;
- 21 3. [\$72,000] \$89,900 in calendar year [2004] 2009;
- 22 4. [\$72,000] \$95,200 in calendar year [2005] 2010; and
- 23 5. [\$74,000 in] IN calendar year [2006] 2011 and thereafter,
24 NO LESS THAN THE SALARY OF A COMMAND STAFF 2 IN THE BALTIMORE CITY
25 POLICE DEPARTMENT AT THE MIDPOINT IN THE PAY SCALE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
3 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Baltimore City in office on the effective
4 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation
5 of the Sheriff of Baltimore City shall take effect at the beginning of the next following
6 term of office.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2005.
