A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN	ACT	concerning

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Anne Arundel County Maryland Fire-Rescue 3 Services Memorial Sculpture
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 6 Maryland Fire-Rescue Services Memorial Foundation, Inc. for certain
- 7 development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan
- 8 proceeds; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan
- 9 proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing
- 10 the loan.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Anne Arundel
- 15 County Maryland Fire-Rescue Services Memorial Sculpture Loan of 2005 in the
- 16 total principal amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 17 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 18 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland
- 29 Fire Rescue Services Memorial Foundation, Inc. for the planning, design, and
- 30 construction of a monument honoring all emergency fire, rescue, and EMS men and

- 1 women who have given their lives in the line of duty while serving their communities,
- 2 located in Annapolis.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 8 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2012. If any
- 9 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 10 2012, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 11 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 12 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 13 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 15 effect June 1, 2005.
