A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class BR Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of altering in Carroll County the minimum number of days per week  
4 that a holder of a Class BR beer, wine and liquor restaurant license must keep  
5 the restaurant open for business; and generally relating to Class BR licenses in  
6 Carroll County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 6-201.

21 (h) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Carroll County.

22 (4) (iii) The Board may issue a Class BR beer, wine and liquor license to  
23 an applicant who owns or operates a restaurant that:

24 1. Serves at least one full-course evening dinner meal at  
25 least [6] 5 days a week;
