9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

The City of Gaithersburg was incorporated under a charter of the Maryland General Assembly on April 5, 1878 as a body politic endowed with legislative powers to administer local and internal government affairs within the corporate limits. Pursuant to Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland, the City of Gaithersburg is empowered as a branch of the State Government to carry out municipal functions thorough Council Manager form of government. Accordingly, the Mayor and City Council have adopted the City Code which is comprised of laws to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the 57,365 residents of Gaithersburg. Based on the 2003 Census update released in July 2004, Gaithersburg is the second largest municipality in the State.

10. Description and Purpose of Project

The Gaithersburg Aquatic and Recreation Center has been a key element of the City's "Parks, Recreation, and Open Space for the 21st Century" master plan, adopted by the Mayor & Council in November of 1999.

This project provides for the planning, design and construction of a new aquatic and recreation center. Because of its prime location along the Route 28 corridor, this facility will serve the growing western region of Gaithersburg to include not only city residents and schools, but also the many communities outside the city limits.

The facility will feature a fitness/competition lap pool and a separate shallow water leisure/instructional pool. It will also include a large gymnasium, a health and exercise room, as well as all the required support spaces such as locker/shower rooms, lobby and administrative areas, and parking.

The City purchased the land for \$3,200,000. To date, the City has appropriated an additional \$4,170,000 for design and construction.
