## 10. Description and Purpose of Project

The Cultural Heritage Center will be a 20,000square foot facility dedicated to preserving and interpreting the history of African Americans in Prince George's County. Located in North Brentwood, the oldest incorporated African American community in the County, the Center will include a permanent exibition hall; a temporary gallery hosting treveling exhibitions and the work of contemporary artists; a 200-seat theater/ performance space; education facilities; and a sculpture garden. As a museum, repository, and performance venue the Center will provide public programing, exibits, educational, educational activities linking the Center to publice school in Prince George's
