6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the Creation of a State debt, the proceeds to serve as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Grand United Order of Odd Fellows Sandy Spring Lodge # 6430, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and preservation of the Odd Fellows Hall, located in Sandy Spring.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of real property. The fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

8. Special Provisions

Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual easement to the extent of its interest.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

The Grand Order of the Odd Fellows is the oldest African American Lodge in Maryland. This Lodge served as a school, hospital, religious, and social organization from 1906-present.

10. Description and Purpose of Project

To commence renovation of the 1906 Odd Fellows Lodge in Sandy Spring, as a historic site representing the aspirations of the post-slavery African Amrican community during and after the segregation periods in Maryland. Project to include, selective demolition, foundation and masonry repairs, carpentry, framing and roofing of the structure.
